

**MINUTES OF PIPERTON BOARD OF
MAYOR AND COMMISSIONER WORK SESSION
March 9, 2020, 5:30 P.M.**

The Piperton Board of Mayor and Commissioners met in a work session on March 9, 2020 at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall.
